- 3. The school shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to the weaker section and the disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and Compulsory Elementary Education till its completion:

Provided, that in case of Pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.

- 4. For the children testered to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per subsection 2 of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursement, the school shall provide a separate bank account.
